Dear Seasons of Learning Families,

I was informed today that our school custodian has tested positive for the COVID-19 Virus. This individual has been testing weekly in order to visit their father who is in hospice. We continue to work with the Macomb County Health Department and our own back to school Covid-19 Plan to follow the appropriate guidelines and protocols.

The guidelines require an individual that has close contact (less than six feet for greater than 15 minutes in a 24-hour period) to a person with Covid-19, to self-quarantine at home for 14 days. I have talked to the Seasons of Learning Staff in this specific case, and no other individuals have spent the 15 minutes within 6 feet to be considered a close contact. Our custodian does not have close contact with any of the students in the building, and there has been no preschool classes this past Thursday and Friday due to parent teacher conferences/home visits.

School will continue as normal this week.

Our school custodian will be able to return to school after the 10-day quarantine period has ended, provided they do not have any symptoms, or they have received a negative test. As an extra precaution, I have been in the building on Sunday and re-sanitized the classrooms.

Please pray for our custodian and for all of the staff, students and families at St. Peter's School and Seasons of Learning Preschool.
